HEALTH & SAFETY

All exhibitors are required to complete a simple risk assessment and provide a copy of your public liability insurance in advance, by [email to Nick Rawlings](#)– failure to do so may mean you are unable to exhibit at the event. The deadline for us to receive your risk assessment & insurance certificate is Friday 9 October – thanks in advance for your help with this.

In addition, all electrical devices including extensions etc need to be PAT tested prior to use.

POWER

We can provide access to an electrical socket if you require one – ***pls let us know if you require power.*** We have to pay extra for power to each exhibition stand, and as such we are only providing it on request. If you don't pre-order a socket, it may still be possible to provide this on the day, but it will be at your own expense.

REFRESHMENTS

You are entitled to take tea and coffee with the other delegates. A separate buffet will be provided for exhibitors either before or after the official lunch break on each day, to enable you to maximise the opportunity to meet and talk to delegates.

OTHER ADVICE

We suggest you keep your display very simple and informal - that will best suit the tone of the event.
